# **DPAC Report – Amy Mackenzie**

- District budget preliminary overview:
  - \$3.85 million in budget pressures for next year. This includes \$800,000 increase in substitute costs, teacher salary increases of \$1.5 million, \$750,000 for inflation, and \$500,000 for a technology refresh.
- Holly Clark spoke on AI and using it effectively in the schools. The superintendent said Abbotsford is 1 of 4 districts in the province that are actively embracing AI to see how students can use it.
- Reminder for PACs to apply early for BCEID to apply for the gaming grant.
- Next School Board meeting is April 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:00pm
- BCCPAC AGM and Conference is in Prince George from May 23-25. PACs should assign a proxy if not attending.
