



Welcome to Kindergarten at Swift!

We are looking forward to seeing you and your children at school for the 2025-26 School Year. Here are a few things that you need to know:

1. **Volunteering!** We can't do some of the things we do without parent volunteers (grandparents are awesome too!). If you want to volunteer at school, the first step is getting your Criminal Record Check. This is done through the School Board Office (2790 Tims St). You can get all the info on our <u>website</u> or follow the link on this QR code. As it takes a few weeks to clear the CRC, taking care of this over the summer is the best way to be prepared for September opportunities!



2. Paying for things! The Abbotsford School District uses "SchoolCash" to process all payments for school fees and field trips as well as permissions and consent forms. Please check out how to create an account or add a student to an existing account. This payment system will follow your child throughout their time in the Abbotsford School District. Registering for your SchoolCash account is mandatory. We do not accept any cash payments at the school. You can get information on SchoolCash here or follow the link on the QR code. This will be available to you starting in August.



3. **School Supplies!** School Supply lists are loaded on our website and ready for you to order. <u>Check it out Here</u> or scan the QR code. Supplies can be purchased through "School Start" or purchased at a store. All online orders are delivered to your home address. Please note that there is a list for Regular Kindergarten and one for Nature Kindergarten.
